

General Information

1. Entry deadline: Sunday, November 6
Starting time: Thursday, November 10
2. Entry fees include Saturday lunch, court time, balls, and refreshments.
3. Players may play in 1 skill level and 1 age level, and up to three events (3rd EVENT MUST BE MIXED DOUBLES ONLY)
4. Players must check in 30 minutes prior to a match. Courts will be assigned when all players have checked in for the match. 15 minutes late for a match may result in a forfeit.
5. Match winners must referee or find a suitable replacement. Last round match winners are required to show up and referee first round matches the next day. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.
6. Official Ball: Wilson
7. The tournament director reserves the right to:
 - a. Reclassify players
 - b. Combine or cancel divisions with less than 6 entrants.
 - c. Advance, delay or reschedule matches as needed.
8. USRA approved lens eye wear is required apparel for all players. The protective eye wear must be worn as designed and may not be altered. Players who require corrective eye wear also must wear lensed eye wear designed for racquet sports. Failure to wear protective eye wear will result in a technical, and the player will be charged with a time-out to secure eye wear. The second infraction in the same match will result in a forfeit (USRA rule 2.5).
9. Children must be supervised at all times during the tournament.
10. The ELITE division is available to mens's open players that have not received points in the standings as of entry deadline
